City Attorney Johnnie Brown was not present.

INVOCATION/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: The Invocation was given by Councilwoman Brenda Tyler and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilman Al Walls.

FUTURES DATES OF COUNCIL: COUNCILMAN ANDY SHAMBLIN MADE THE MOTION THAT THE FIRST MEETING IN JUNE BE HELD ON THURSDAY, JUNE 2 WITH A SECOND BY COUNCILMAN AL WALLS. VOTE WAS FOR THE MOTION. Mayor Casebolt said the future dates of Council are June 21, July 1 at 10:00 am to swear in new Council members, July 5 and July 19.

SPEEDING ISSUES: Micky Raynes of Hillside Drive told Council he was concerned about speeding traffic on the streets in his neighborhood on Hillside Drive. Nitro Police Chief Steve Walker said he would address the problem. Councilwoman Brenda Tyler said that this is also a problem in her neighborhood. Chief Walker said that he would step up patrols in both areas.
