April 2, 2024

The Nitro Convention and Visitors Bureau met on Tuesday, March 5, 2024. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Chairman Bill Javins and held in Nitro City Council Chambers. Those attending the meeting in person were Bill Javins, Ivan Meadows, Susan Valleau, Matthew Lawrence, Cynthia McGill, Kato Moy, Julia Washington, Kelli Steele, and Dave Casebolt, Executive Director Joe Stevens was also present.

A quorum was determined, and the minutes were reviewed and a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting was made by Susan Valleau and seconded by Kato Moy. The motion was adopted.

A March financial report was presented by Joe Stevens and a motion to accept the report was made by Matthew Lawrence and seconded by Kelli Steele. The motion was adopted.

Chairman Javins opened discussion on the CVB helping the Nitro Sustainable Committee (Beekeepers) financially, due to the fact of the tourism draw of the facility. Chairman Javins entertained a motion to provide \$1000 in funding for educational signage. A motion was made to grant the funding by Ivan Meadows and seconded by Matthew Lawrence. The motion was adopted.

Joe Stevens presented to the board his director's report. Stevens went over upcoming events in the city. Stevens reported on the Wars Museum's article in WV Living Magazine. Stevens gave an overview of the city's events committee and their plans for upcoming events.

In New Business, Stevens gave an update on the Ridenour Lake Trail Expansion. Valleau provided an update on the museum's visitation and that the Vietnam Memorial continues to be a large draw for visitors. A ceremony honoring former CVB Board member and museum curator Carmen Kostelansky will be held on April 11. Matthew Lawrence gave the board an update on the booking of tournaments at the Athletic Complex for this coming season and that the complex will now be open whenever the weather permits. Mayor Casebolt reported the city had received a \$1.2 million grant from the state to cover the pickleball courts. Moy talked about the happenings at Mardi Gra Casino & Resort. He also mentioned an upcoming remodeling of the hotel. Cynthia McGill announced there will be open mic nights at Living Memorial Park beginning in May.

With no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:30 pm on a motion by Susan Valleau and seconded by Kato Moy. The next meeting to take place, May 7, 2024.
