## STORMWATER HOTLINE

Stormwater runoff is from rain and snowmelt that flows over land or impervious surfaces (paved streets, parking lots, building rooftops) and does not soak into the ground. The runoff picks up pollutants such as trash, chemicals, oils, and dirt/sediment that will harm our rivers, streams, and lakes. If these storm sewer drainage systems are also not clean and working properly, it can cause localized flooding.



If you see a storm drain not working correctly, see a grate covered/blocked, or see something entering a storm drain that shouldn't be (oil, mud, or chemicals), let us know and photos always help.
